#### 'Nobody calls it Czechia': Czech Republic's new name isn't popular

When the authorities decided to change the Czech Republic's official name, they didn't test the idea first. Six months after the country's leaders officially replaced Czech Republic with the name of Czechia, its citizens continue to call it the Czech Republic.

Czech leaders replaced the Czech Republic with Czechia as the country's everyday name. The name Czech Republic would not disappear entirely, but the authorities thought it was too long for international business or to attract foreign investment. Czechia would be an easier name to recognize.

The British government has agreed to recognize the name Czechia. The US state department has officially adopted Czechia as the short-form name, together with the longer version. The trouble is, Czechia is not catching on at home. Czech authorities continue to use the term Czech Republic on official communications and English-language websites.

According to Jan Urban, a professor and political analyst at New York University in Prague, Czechia isn't for official use by the state. It's for everyday use, as with Britain rather than Great Britain or France rather than the French Republic.
