- No extraneous governmental interference - but still have the ability to meet with government regulators and discuss projects & issues



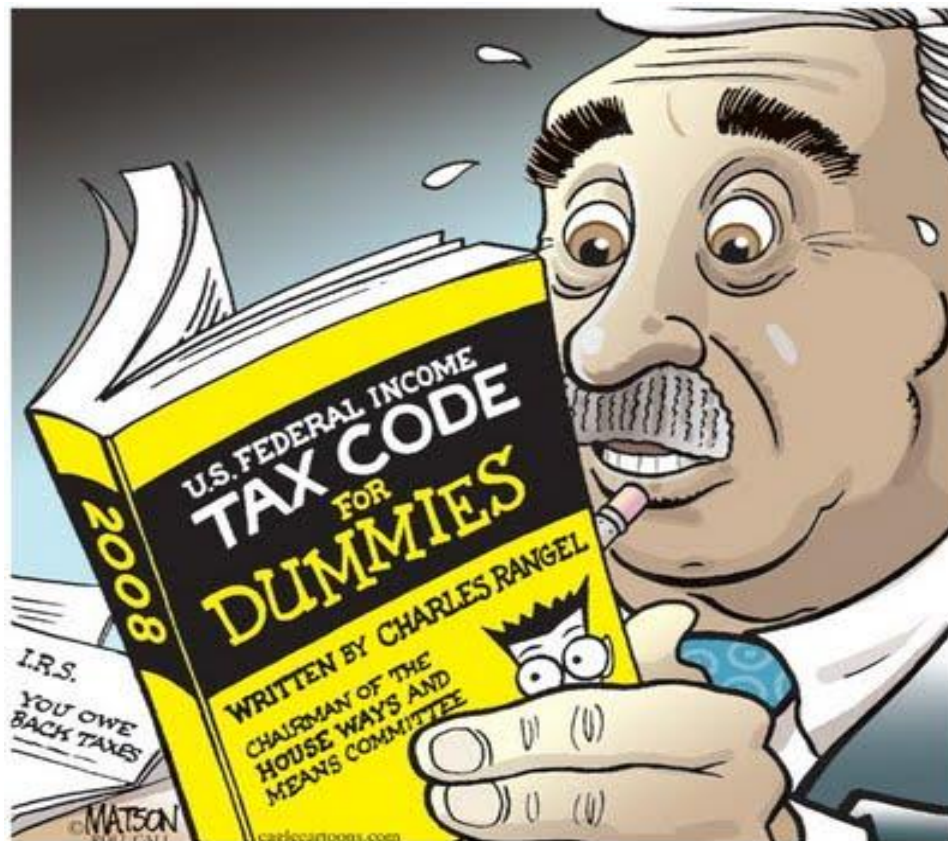
- Legislation that supports business - or at least that doesn't hurt business
