Dear AFG friends and Partners,

On April 14, 2018 Rushmore Motorcycles Georgia LLC organized Charity Ride with up to 200 Motor-bikers participating in it. The funds raised during the event was donated to American Friends of Georgia's project "Dzegvi Shelter Community" and two kids 2-year-old Nini Chkhikvadze and 4-year-old Zakaria Shiukashvili who needed immediate therapeutical rehabilitation courses.

The Dzegvi Shelter Community is the only free center of its kind in the country of Georgia, where vulnerable individuals of all ages live together as one large family. Last year American Friends of Georgia with support of long term partners and friends, with proceeds of 2 Charity Galas started reconstruction of Dzegvi Shelter building. The reconstruction will enable the Shelter to receive more beneficiaries and at the same time run physiological, art rehabilitation and vocational programs for the Shelter inhabitants to help them recover from the stresses they have undergone and to enable to reintegrate into the society.

Rushmore Motorcycles Georgia's Charity Ride started off on Nutsubidze street and ended up at around 3 o'clock in the Shelter in Armazi Gorge. The Shelter inhabitants have been waiting for the guests into Dzegvi courtyard since the very morning. And the appearance of the Bikers brought a lot of joy and happiness especially to kids. 1700 GEL raised during the event was given to the Shelter. Besides, the financial contribution, cereal products, cookies and sweets, clothes and toys for children were donated to Dzegvi Shelter Community.

American Friends of Georgia would like to thank each and every Biker participating in the event, head of Rushmore Motorcycles Georgia LLC Graham Hodge, Honorary Consul Cliff Isaak for organizing such a wonderful event and would like to hope that this kind of events will be held more often to help those who are in need.
