Following several months of planning, in the first week of May, Enviroserve Georgia successfully coordinated its first collection of discarded IT equipment.

This operation was carried out in conjunction with HeidelbergCement, who required to dispose of the material as part of their office relocation process.



The material will now be shipped to Enviroserve’s sophisticated recycling plant in Dubai, where it will be recycled in complete compliance with international environment requirements.

An increasing concern to organizations disposing of IT equipment is the security of their sensitive, confidential historic information, perhaps remaining on hard drives and other storage devices. The professional service of Enviroserve in UAE offers the issuance of detailed Certificates of Destruction. These certificates detail the items destroyed, and, if required, they can be supported by photographic evidence of the specific recycling operation. Enviroserve also welcome clients to witness the operation themselves.
