Deadline for Compliance with the Law on Entrepreneurs

Commercial entities registered in Georgia before 1 January 2022 must bring their corporate documents into compliance with the Law on Entrepreneurs (the “**Law**”) by 1 April 2026 (extended from 1 April 2025).

This requires submitting to the Entrepreneurial Registry the founding documents and charters brought in line with the Law and activating the authorized user portal of the enterprise.

From 1 April 2026, non-compliant entities will have their registration suspended, restricting operations (including contracting, banking, and asset disposal) and making the suspension publicly visible.

If compliance is still not achieved by 1 January 2027, a final 3-month deadline will be granted for curing the non-compliance, failure of which will result in deregistration.

In the absence of any announced extension, non-compliant entities risk becoming inoperable and are therefore strongly advised to act without delay.
