The 100-Year-Old Post Building and New Street in Tbilisi

In the old districts of Tbilisi, hundreds of buildings have been preserved, some of which are nearly a century old. Many of these buildings are designated as historical sites, though the preservation of these structures is hindered by financial issues and ineffective architectural projects, focused solely on their appearance will not be enough. Between 1880 and 1900, designed by Mikhail Vorontsov, the village of "Kukia" became a district. The Aghmashenebeli Avenue started during this period. Originally, the street was named after Nikolayev Avenue in honor of Mikhail Nikolaevich Romanov, the Grand Duke of Georgia. The streets were laid out in Mikhail's design. The sidewalks paved.
